

LONG HILL TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY DAY BATTLE OF THE BANDS

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Long Hill Township Community Day will host a Battle of the Bands on September 4, 2010 (rain date Sept.5th) from 6:00PM – 9:00PM at Riverside Park in Gillette, NJ. Riverside Park is located behind the Long Hill Municipal Building and Library at 915 Valley Road, Gillette, NJ, 07933. Bands will be selected in the order received and need to submit media such as a CD or website that has a sample of their music.

- Although not a requirement, priority will be given to bands that have at least one member from Long Hill Township
- Band names and songs cannot contain obscenities
- Fire, pyrotechnics, fog machines, etc. are not allowed
- Drugs, alcohol, and tobacco are not allowed
- Bands that incite moshing or any other sort of violence in the crowd will be disqualified
- There will be ample stage microphones and monitors provided by “Steinwand Sound Studios” of Newton, NJ along with their 13,000 watt sound system
- Bands will need to bring their own drums, instruments and small amplifiers. The amplifiers and drums will be “miked” through the sound system provided
- Steinwand Sound Studios is offering 3 hours of studio time to the winner of the event
- All bands must be present at the end of the event for the announcement of winners
- Bands must complete the Battle of the Bands sign up form. This form can be found and downloaded from the [Long Hill Township website](#) under the announcements section of the home page
- Bands must sign the hold harmless release form. This form can be found and downloaded from the [Long Hill Township website](#) under the announcements section of the home page
- In the event of darkness lighting will be provided
